

Exceptional Pupils Specific to the level of the base teaching license Gifted and Talented Education (GATE)

NAC 391.394

To receive an endorsement to teach in a program of gifted and talented education, a person must:

- 1. Hold a license for the level of education in which the program is offered; and
 - 2. Have two (2) years of verified experience as a teacher in schools approved by the department; and
- 3. Have completed twelve (12) semester hours of credit from an accredited college or university to include three (3) semester hours of credit in each of the following areas of study:
 - A. Characteristics and needs of gifted and talented pupils.
 - B. Assessment of gifted and talented pupils and programs for such pupils.
 - C. Curriculum in content areas for gifted and talented pupils; and
 - D. Methodology and strategies for teaching gifted and talented pupils.
