

## **Exceptional Pupils Ages 3-21 Orientation and Mobility**

NAC 391.391

- 1. Complete the general requirements for all educator licenses: General License Requirements
- 2. Bachelor's or more advanced degree from an accredited college/university in orientation and mobility; or
- 3. Bachelor's or more advanced degree from an accredited college/university and completion of an orientation and mobility program at a university approved by the Association for Education and Rehabilitation of the Blind and Visually Impaired; or
- 4. Specialty credential as a Certified Orientation and Mobility Specialist from the Academy for Certification of Vision Rehabilitation and Education Professionals or its successor organization.

Note: This endorsement is not required to teach pupils in a program of orientation and mobility
