43 % of the students attending Nevada public schools are Hispanic, which is the majority ethnic student group in Nevada, followed by 32% Whites. 66% of the total student population reside in Clark County while Esmeralda county has less than 0.02% of the population.

46 % of the 3rd graders are proficient in Reading. On the 2019 SBAC ELA assessments, Asian students performed the highest in all grades.

SBAC results indicate **50%** of **elementary** school students demonstrated proficiency in ELA while **43.8%** met that mark in Math.

5 hyear in a row, enrollment grew by at least **2** percentage points, increasing from 485,768 in 2017-2018 to 498,616.

LEAs reported that out of **61%** free and reduced price lunch/breakfast eligible students, only **25%** ate lunch and **12%** ate breakfast on a single school day.

84 percent of high school students graduated in 2018-2019. Engagement in career and technical education (CTE) pathways again led to a higher rate of **94%**, compared to the overall rate. Statewide, rates increased across all racial and ethnic groups except American Indian/Alaska Native students, including a roughly 4% point jump for Pacific Islander students.

The State of Nevada Students

Average per pupil spending for the state was **\$9,109** during 2018-19 school year, a **3 %** decrease from 2017-18 school year.

In 2019, **12** percent of Nevada graduates met all four ACT College Readiness Benchmarks, which is the same as 2018. **20** percent of Nevada graduates met three of the four ACT College Readiness Benchmarks.
