


COVID-19 Focus Groups

Three major topic areas are outlined in the Educator Perspective

- + Reflecting on distance learning experiences— specifically regarding the initial transition from in-person to digital learning, factors that attributed to the lack of preparedness for a smooth transition, and supporting the social and emotional needs of students.
- +Sharing lessons learned to inform the plan for returning to school—including addressing learning loss among students.
- +Considering policy implications at both the district and state levels—including what educators believe is the number one priority for district leadership, school boards, and committees planning for reopening.

Teacher Retention

- +Recommendation: Establish a Formal Method to Learn Why Teachers Leave and What Would Induce Them to Stay
 - + Conduct an Online Exit Survey
 - Reasons teachers are leaving and where they are going
 - Effective strategies for teacher retention
 - Potential predictors of teacher turnover and mobility
 - Profiles of schools likely to experience higher rates of teacher turnover
 - + Use a Third-Party Researcher
 - + Include an Incentive for Participation



Restorative Justice Practices

- +Recommendation 1: Provide professional learning to all teaching and support staff and administration onculturally responsive restorative justice practices
- +Recommendation 2: Advocate for comprehensive collaboration among community stakeholders
- +Recommendation 3: Construct a model of implementation of restorative justice for district and schools (AB168)

- +Recommendation 1: Identify And Emphasize The 'Bright Spots' Of Teacher Leadership In District Schools
