

## Washoe County School District Amended Work-Based Learning Plan Summary 2019-20 Second Semester

## **Original Plan:**

The original Washoe County School District (WCSD) work-based learning (WBL) plan required students to accrue a minimum of 90 documented hours per semester between time spent at an employer host site and time spent on out-of-class coursework.

## Amendment:

For Quarter 1 of Semester 2, School Year 2019-20, students in individual and group internships for academic credit will be required to have accrued at least 30 documented hours between time spent at an employer host site and time spent on out-of-class coursework.

For Quarter 2 of Semester 2, School Year 2019-20, students will be required to have accrued at least 30 documented hours between time spent on final digital presentations, weekly virtual meetings with an instructor, final project work, and modules completed for the WCSD Distance Learning course, "Career Planning & Development."

To earn ½ credit for the WBL course, students will complete a minimum of 60 hours combined between the activities for Quarter 1 and Quarter 2 of Semester 2.
