**4. Review of Statutory and Regulatory Provisions Related to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 388G and Actions from the 83rd Legislative Session** *(Information, Discussion, and for Possible Action)*

The Subcommittee will review the statutory provisions in NRS 388G.500 – 388G.810 and corresponding regulations in Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 388G.100 – 140, as well as related actions taken during the 83rd Legislative Session. The discussion will focus on identifying provisions that may benefit from additional regulatory guidance to ensure effective implementation, clarity, and oversight.

**5. Development of a Planning Timeline and Milestones for Changes in Regulatory Language** *(Information, Discussion, and for Possible Action)*

The Subcommittee will engage in a planning discussion to outline a proposed timeline for evaluating and potentially drafting changes or additions to existing regulatory language under NAC 388G. This item will include identification of consultation needs with external entities (e.g., Clark County School District Board of Trustees Members and School District Staff) and consideration of how revised regulatory guidance may impact processes for both the school district and precincts. The Subcommittee may take action to approve a preliminary timeline and assign responsibilities for next steps.
