The Special Education course will be added to the middle, secondary, K-12 Art, and K-12 Music initial prep programs. Additionally, Computer Science will be added as a middle school endorsement and the Education Technology course will be updated. Finally, the fees for review of application will be increased. The Commission may approve or not approve moving this regulation to a Public Hearing.
