



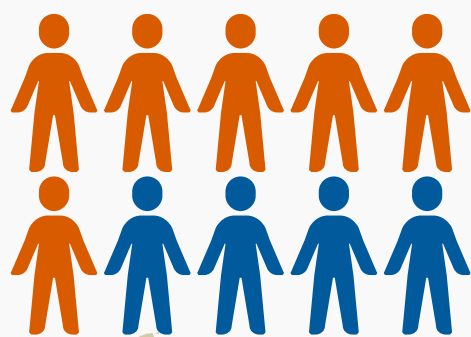

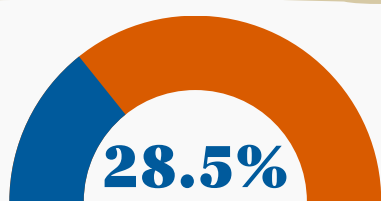
of 479,578 statewide student population is American Indian/Alaska Native (AI/AN) students, which corresponds to a little less than 1% of the state student population. *

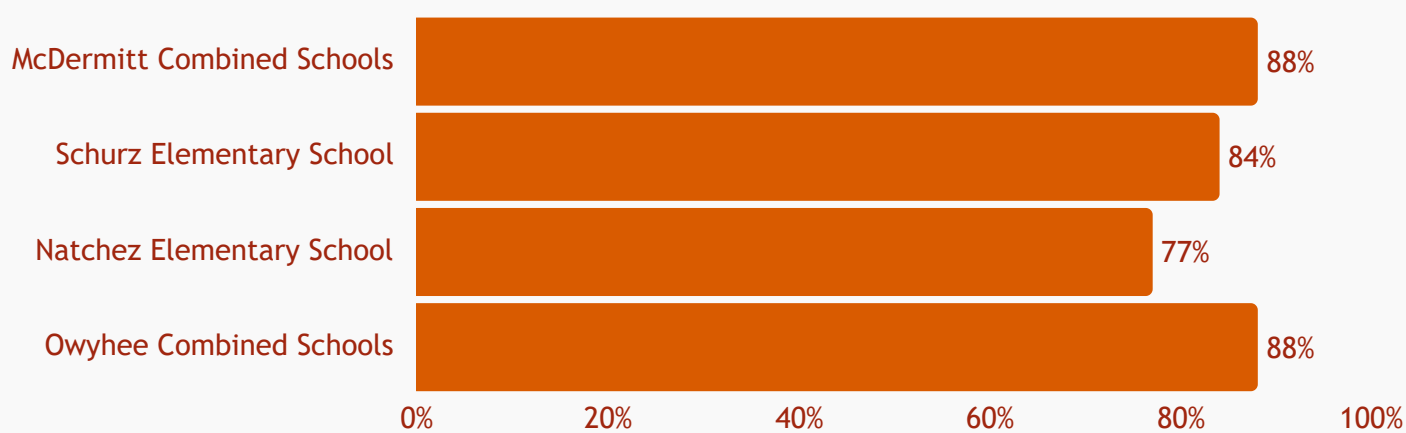

Nevada Tribes speak different languages, each with a multitude of dialects: **Numu** (Northern Paiute), **Nuwu** (Southern Paiute), **Waší·šiw** (Washoe), **Newe** (Western Shoshone), and **Pipa Aha Macav** (Fort Mojave).

Northern Paiute, Southern Paiute, Washoe, Western Shoshone, and Fort Mojave

are the indigenous people that have historically made Nevada their home.
