

There are 20 federally recognized tribes comprised of 28 tribal communities indigenous to Nevada.



Nevada Tribes speak different languages, each with a multitude of dialects: Numu (Northern Paiute), Nuwu (Southern Paiute), Waší·šiw (Washoe), Newe (Western Shoshone), and Pipa Aha Macav (Fort Mojave).

Northern Paiute, Southern Paiute, Washoe, Western Shoshone, and Fort Mojave

are the indigenous people that have historically made Nevada their home.
