Dear Superintendent Ebert,

The Student Investment Division, in consultation with the Budget Division of the Office of Finance and the Fiscal Analysis Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau determined the recommended minimum amount of money to be expended for textbooks, instructional supplies, instructional software and instructional hardware by districts, charter schools, and university schools for profoundly gifted pupils per NRS 387.2062 for Fiscal Year 2023.

All districts, charter schools, and university schools for the profoundly gifted met the recommended minimum amount except for the following:

School	Minimum Expenditure Recommendation	Actual Per Pupil Expenditure
Carson Montessori	\$131.09	\$114.56

As noted in the attached response, that had funding associated with the 600 series object codes in the chart of accounts been included, Carson Montessori would have met the recommended expenditure amount. Because Carson Montessori is an experimental learning school, many of their hands on materials are provided by partners in education. This results in lower textbook material expenditures.
