



## Approved Nevada Department of Education Science of Reading Professional Development Courses and Pathways

Senate Bill (SB) 460§56.2 mandates that a school district and the governing body of a charter school shall ensure that a course of professional development training in the Science of Reading (SOR) that is approved by the Nevada Department of Education (NDE) is successfully completed. The course must include phonological and phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension. The approved list below is maintained by the Nevada Department of Education and will expand as new courses receive approval.
