3. 2021 LEGISLATIVE SESSION UPDATE

The director of the Office of Inclusive Education at the Nevada Department of Education provided information of special education bills being brought forward at the Legislative Session. Discussion ensued:

- Lots and lots of bills went by the wayside to be discussed another day.
- Of the bills we have been tracking together.
- SB169 is no more.
- AB67 went through a slight LCB revision. No substantive changes to the language there. Continuing to monitor that one close.
- SB210 the bill came out, issues with the language and the law. Most likely wasn't going to pass. Took feedback willing and the passage should go through. This bill will be passing
- No big LCB changes or anything like that.

- SB179- higher standards for hearing interpreters. ADSD acquiesced to the changes. Question about the form of the changes. Did the language serve the purpose the district was wanting? Went through legal and decided that it did. This bill will be passing.
- Collect all the feedback and put together a concept. During first workshop, supposed to be receiving public feedback. Draft something up. Have lawyers take a look to make sure no laws are being broken. SEAC, SEDA, and all of the committees.
