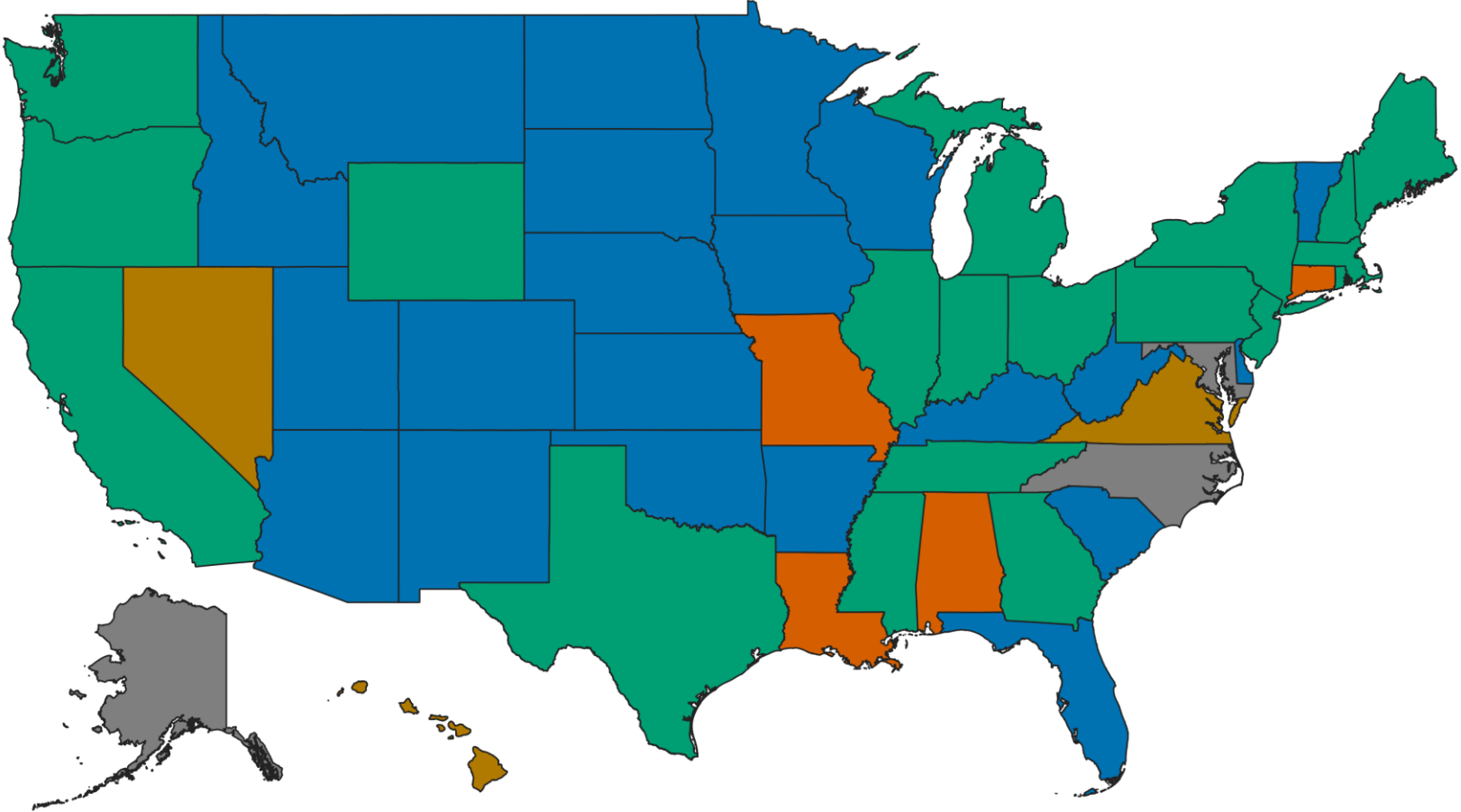

By State | Inter-District Enrollment

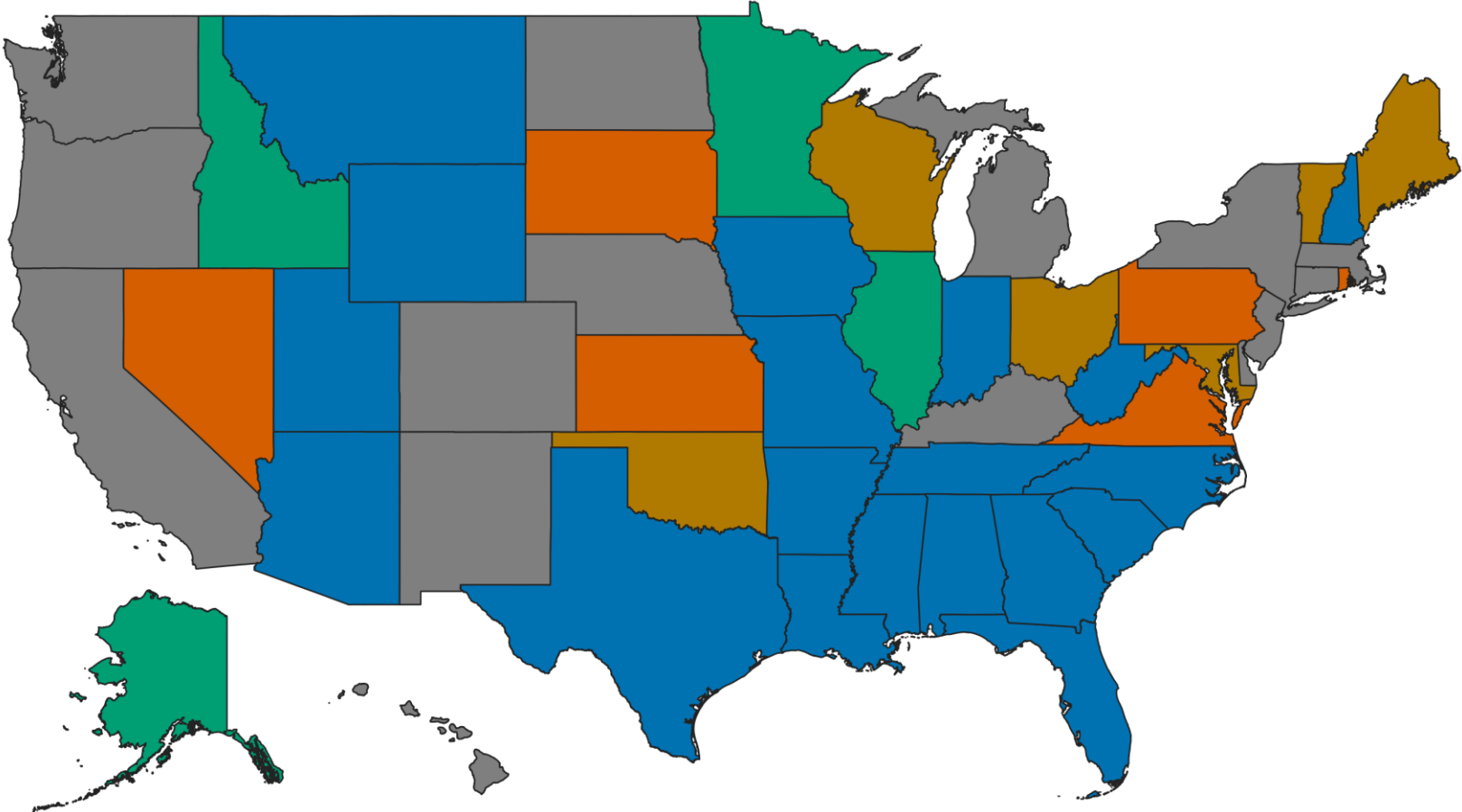

Nevada 2025 Legislative Overview

AB533

Assembly Bill 533

Objective: An act seeking to allow students to attend public schools outside their zoned district.

Details:

- A student can enroll in any public school as long as it is not at capacity for their grade level.
- No need for annual re-application.
- A lottery system will be used when there are more student applicants than seats.
- Districts are not required to provide transportation for these students.
- NDE must establish a grant program to help fund transportation for these students.

Assembly: Passed (May 31, 2025)

Senate: Passed (June 2, 2025)

Governor: Signed (June 11, 2025)

Nevada 2025 Legislative Overview

AB599

Assembly Bill 599

Objective: An act aiming to expand the Opportunity Scholarship program.

Details:

- Would increase the annual tax-credit cap from \$6.7 million to \$10.7 million.
- Would impose new reporting, auditing and academic accountability requirements on scholarship organizations and participating schools.

Nevada 2025 Legislative Overview

AB214

Assembly Bill 214

Objective: An act aiming to expand the Opportunity Scholarship program.

Details:

- Would expand the tax-credit to \$30 million with 10 percent annual increases.
- Would expand eligibility for scholarships by raising the household income threshold to 400 percent of the area median income
- Would establishing a minimum scholarship of \$1,000.

Federal Tax Credit Scholarship Program

Federal Tax Credit Scholarship Program

Objective: A federal tax credit program intended to provide taxpayers with a credit for donations related to educational funding.

Details:

- Created under the One Big Beautiful Bill.
- Provides a \$1,700 tax credit to donors who help state-approved scholarship-granting organizations (SGOs) that award grants to families to attend K-12 private schools.
- Scholarship funds can be used for a variety of expenses including tuition, tutoring, special education services, computers and educational materials.
- Family must have a household income at or below 300 percent of the area median income.

Status: Enrolled January 23, 2026, and begins in 2027
