SB 460, Sect. 62 (2025)

For a regular session, the Commission on School Funding may request the drafting of not more than 1 legislative measure which relates to matters within the scope of the Commission.

Enrollment Counts

Additional review to be conducted at the May 15 Commission Meeting. Any changes made to hold harmless, the exceptional enrollment growth adjustment, or the current quarterly ADE process would require a statutory change.

Weight Stacking

On February 20, 2026, the Commission made a motion to support the concept of stacking weights with the exclusion of Special Education; recognizes the potential for discounted weights to account for service overlaps (such as EL and At-Risk); and recommends that stacking be implemented contingent upon additional state funding being provided to hit specific fiscal triggers, with exact details to be brought back in the final report for Commission approval.

Auxiliary Tier Funding for Charters

On April 24, 2026, the Commission made recommendations as they apply to the Auxiliary Tier of the Pupil-Centered Funding Plan that funds district transportation and food services. Charters would receive the same funding methodology as districts. A statutory change is required to include charters into the auxiliary tier for transportation reimbursement.

At-Risk Definition

On March 22, 2024, the Commission voted to remove the quintile that is currently encoded into law and allow the number of pupils who qualify for an at-risk weight to be determined each biennium by the Nevada Board of Education.
