

# FY26 Grants Information Webinar FAQ

**Updated March 23, 2026**

The following questions come from the Grants Information Webinar held on March 19, 2026, from 9:30am- 10:30am. All applicants are strongly encouraged to read the full Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) [Grant Information](#) for complete details.

**1. What is the purpose of this grant?**

The grant provides \$100,000 for fiscal year 2026-2027 to educational organizations, professional development providers, and nonprofits to provide specialized training that strengthens the Nevada Educator Performance Framework (NEPF).

**2. What are the key priorities for the award?**

Priority is given to proposals aligned with Teachers and Leaders Council (TLC) recommendations, specifically focusing on Administrator Standards 1 and 4, and Teacher Instructional Practice Standard 4.

**3. When is the application deadline?**

The submission window opened on March 16th and will close on April 3rd.

**4. What is the period of performance?**

The grant period runs from July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027.

**5. When is the final Request for Reimbursement (RFR) due?**

The final RFR is due by July 21, 2027. All funds must be expended by June 30, 2027.

**6. When must the Final Financial Report (FFR) be completed?**

The FFR is expected to be finished by the end of July 2027 to allow for fiscal year close-out.

**7. Do I need to submit policy documents if I already did so for another grant?**

Yes. You must submit documentation for each individual grant because different offices and grantees oversee them.

**8. Are applicants required to present their projects?**

Yes, selected applicants or a team representative must be prepared to present to the Statewide Coordinating Council on April 27th at 4:00 PM. You will be notified of that

selection by Tuesday, April 21st, 2026, no later than 4:00PM

**9. What if my organization does not have an internal board for approval signatures (Appendix D)?**

If a board is not required by your organizational structure, you may mark that section as "not applicable".
