

Nevada Financial Literacy Council: June 3, 2026 In-Person Meeting Plan

1. Purpose of the Meeting

The Nevada Financial Literacy Council will hold its annual statutory in-person meeting on June 3, 2026, in Las Vegas at the Junior Achievement facility.

This meeting will fulfill governance responsibilities, establish direction for the upcoming legislative and program year, and will comply with the **Nevada Open Meeting Law (NRS 241)**.

- Confirm committee structure and leadership.
- Establish priority focus areas for the next 12–24 months.
- Review statutory responsibilities and legislative outlook.
- Coordinate statewide initiatives, including Financial Literacy Month.
