Encompass Charter School 2024-2025 School Year

The Curriculum and Instruction department has reviewed the files provided which included:

- 1. Current list of textbooks, supplemental curricula, intervention programs, software, and other curriculum programs currently in use.
- 2. Curriculum maps, pacing guides, lesson plans and/or other applicable curriculum documents to include documentation of how instruction and assessment are tied to standards.
- 3. A copy of the school master schedule.

English:

Curriculum materials provided for grades 9-12 indicate consistent, standards-aligned (NVACS) ELA instruction is occurring. Documentation was provided that demonstrates students are exposed to a variety of diverse and relevant texts and that every genre of writing is being taught throughout each grade-level. Standards are clearly cited, learning objectives aligned, and both formative and summative assessments included.

Commendation: All ELA courses are guided by relevant essential questions and include actionable student objectives.

Mathematics:

The mathematics courses feature clear and concise course plans for each grade level, with pacing that is coherent and realistic, ensuring an effective and manageable progression of content. Additionally, the inclusion of curricular materials with guidance on activities and assessments provides strong support for both teachers and students.

For consideration, it might be beneficial to separate the accountability portion of the grade into its own grade category, for example citizenship or employability skills. This would allow the course grade to reflect solely a student's knowledge and mastery of the standards, ensuring a more accurate representation of academic achievement.

Science:

There is evidence of skills and objectives in the pacing guides for Biology, Physical Science and Environmental Science. The performance expectations are listed by week. Activities, labs and assessments are also included.

Recommendation: Include the cross-cutting concepts, the disciplinary core ideas, and the science and engineering practices learned through the content as prescribed by NVACS.

Social Studies:

Curriculum documents provided indicate that the school provides the required three full years of social studies instruction, including Economics.

Curriculum frameworks and pacing guides indicate alignment to NVACS-SS. The pacing guides utilized are the former Washoe County School District

scope and sequence curriculum documents and include repeated exposure to current NVACS-SS in grades 10 -12. Some instructional resources are identified in the pacing guides.

Commendation: Courses are coherent, standards-aligned, and the suggested resources indicate a focus on rigorous historical thinking.

Recommendations:

- Identify learning objectives and assessments in curriculum maps.
- Consider creating an additional social studies course so that students have the ability to earn the Flex credit through social studies.
