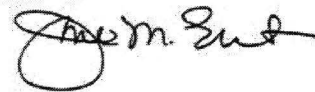

Body Worn Camera Used NARRATIVE On August 19, 2024 I, Officer D. Ciarciaglini #553 working for Clark County School District Police Department (CCSDPD) assigned to Legacy High School (150 W. Deer Springs NLV, NV 89084) was notified via staff that a firearm was located in the staff parking lot of the school. The firearm was recovered, it was later determined to belong to a staff member. The staff member was identified as Jynnell McClellan (DOB [REDACTED] CCW #8525439). At the conclusion of the investigation McClellan was arrested for possession of dangerous weapon on school grounds and transported to Clark County Detention Center. Teacher Chad Bandiera and Kassidy Salters requested Police to the staff parking lot in front of portable #622 in reference to finding a firearm. Officer Larsen #658 and I responded to the area. Upon our arrival, I observed a black firearm identified as a Glock lying between 2 SUV (1 white and 1

Red). Salters advised that she observed the firearm lying next to her front driver side tire and reported it to Bandiera who was carpooling with her. Bandiera advised her to not touch it and contacted CCSDPD.

The location was photographed and then the firearm was rendered safe. The firearm is a Glock 43X 9x19 (9mm) (Serial #BMGB714). The Glock had 10 total rounds in the magazine with 1 loaded in the chamber. The Glock was secured at that time. The Glock firearm will be processed, secured, and booked into CCSDPD evidence accordingly.

The red SUV was identified as a Red 2022 Nissan Pathfinder bearing NV license plate (952ZNJ) (VIN#5N1DR3BB2NC239512). The vehicle registered owner was identified as McClellan.

Dispatch was requested to perform a record check of the firearm (GLOCK), Pathfinder and McClellan to include a Triple III due to the weapon. McClellan returned as having no wants or holds. McClellan does have an active Concealed Carry Weapons Permit (CCW). The vehicle returned as having no wants or holds. The firearm returned as having no record.

McClellan is assigned to room #717 and I initially attempted to make contact with her in the room and was unsuccessful. McClellan was called over the PA system and I saw her walking in the hallway shortly afterward. Contact was made with McClellan in the hallway. McClellan was advised that she was requested by us and that we needed to talk to her in regards to an incident. McClellan is on crutches and was asked if she wanted to come to the police office or any conference room to talk and she advised the police office. Once inside the police office, McClellan was advised of her Miranda Rights which she initially advised didn't need, but was advised of regardless. McClellan advised that she understood and waived her rights. McClellan was advised that a firearm was found next to her vehicle and was asked if it belonged to her. McClellan did not initially answer and was advised that it was reported that she owns a firearm and that this firearm may belong to her. McClellan advised that she has a Glock 43. McClellan then advised that she may have dropped the firearm this morning out of her lockbox when she was unloading her vehicle due to being on crutches. McClellan advised that she doesn't know if she had her firearm in her purse or in the lockbox though. McClellan later advised that she drives Uber and keeps her firearm in a holster in her purse and forgot to remove it this morning. McClellan claimed ownership of the firearm at that time. McClellan asked what would happen next and was advised that she would be arrested and transported to Clark County Detention Center (CCDC). McClellan was cooperative throughout the investigation and continued to ask questions in regards to charges and her employment status.

Principal Belinda Marentic was updated on the incident. Marentic was provided the school keys and Emergency Card given to McClellan via CCSD. Marentic updated EMR on the incident and it was

determined that McClellan would be terminated on the spot. Marentic advised McClellan per NRS 207.200 that if she returned to Legacy HS she would be considered trespassing and subject to arrest. McClellan provided Marentic her purse, bag, and keys to the vehicle and advised that a friend would be by to pick up the items. McClellan was advised that CCSDPD would not be responsible or be present for that exchange. Officer Larsen brought a wheelchair to the police office to transport McClellan to the Patrol unit due to her claiming she was unable to walk and needed crutches. Once McClellan saw the wheel chair she advised that she does not need that and would not get into the chair, but wished to walk. Officer Larsen positioned his patrol unit near the 800 hallway to make it the shortest and most private walk possible. Officer Larsen placed McClellan into 2 handcuffs due to her claim of injury and for comfort purposes. Prior to exiting the building she was searched incident to arrest and nothing of note was discovered on her pursue. Officer Larsen placed her McClellan in the vehicle and secured her with the seatbelt without incident. Jynnell McClellan was transported to Clark County Detention Center and booked in on the below listed charges; • Possession of Dangerous Weapon on School Grounds (Gross Misdemeanor) in violation of NRS 202.265.1F due to the fact that Jynnell McClellan did willfully and unlawfully bring a Glock 43X firearm onto Legacy High School property and dropped it in the parking lot next to her vehicle. • Possession of Dangerous Weapon on School Grounds (Gross Misdemeanor) in violation of NRS 202.265.1G due to the fact that Jynnell McClellan did willfully and unlawfully bring an Asp Metro Defender Keychain Pepper Spray Baton onto Legacy High School property into her assigned classroom and had it in her purse throughout the school day. In addition to the above written report the following occurred. CCSDPD Dispatch was provided a copy of the firearm property sheet via email. Based on the location of the recovered firearm, the version of events described by McClellan does not appear to be accurate. McClellan vehicle was reversed parked into the parking stall with the firearm being discovered next to the driver side rear passenger side of the vehicle. McClellan claimed that the firearm fell out of either her purse or the lock box on the passenger side of the vehicle while obtaining all of her school supplies which would be the opposite side of the vehicle. It is to be notated that the firearm was left out side in the open for the entirety of the school day with her contracted start time being 0646 hrs and the firearm being discovered at 1353 hrs. were present and walked by the loaded firearm for extended periods of time. The school security footage was reviewed utilizing Camera #8 0630 to 0720 hrs on 8-19-2024. CCSD Security services was contacted via email and the security footage was requested for evidence. On 8-21-2024 Security Services Provided the link to the requested video. The video footage was transferred to a DVD+R and secured as evidence. The evidence was booked into CCSDPD evidence accordingly. Camera Review: At 0659 hrs McClellan Pathfinder was observed parking in the parking stall. At 0700 hrs McClellan is observed exiting the vehicle and walking toward the school building. McClellan is not observed going to the passenger side of the vehicle. McClellan is not observed dropping her items as she previously claimed. McClellan is observed walking into the school holding the crutches in 1 hand. Officer Baker #293 and Officer Pinto #377 responded to McClellan room #717 and performed a consensual search of her belongings in the classroom which was granted during the interview. Inside her bag a Asp Pepper Spray Baton key chain was discovered attached to her personal keys. They item was secured as a weapon accordingly. Officer Baker and Officer Pinto also conducted a consensual search of McClellan vehicle and discovered a lock box inside the vehicle as described by McClellan. Nothing else of note was discovered inside the vehicle. Officer Baker provided the Asp Pepper Spray device to me. The Evidence was dropped at the Substation in locker #3 according to policy. Photographs of the items and location were attached to the report. 8-21-2024 Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department Forensic Lab sent a notification that advising that the lab request has been approved for the firearm. On 8-21-2024 statements were collected from Bandiera and Salters in regards to what they witness and actions taken afterward. (2 Statements) End of report (9 attachments)

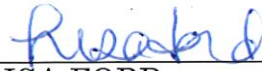

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO HEARING

Jhone Ebert, Superintendent of Public Instruction, Department of Education, State of Nevada ("Petitioner"), hereby petitions the State Board of Education for the revocation of the teacher license held by JYNNELL MCCLELLAN ("Respondent"), issued by the Nevada Department of Education. This Petition and Recommendation for Revocation of License and Notice of Right to Hearing ("Petition and Recommendation") is supported by NRS 391.320, NRS 391.330, and the following allegations:

I. Jurisdiction

Respondent was, at the relevant times mentioned in this Petition and Recommendation, the holder of License No. 106542 issued by the Superintendent of Public Instruction, Department of Education, State of Nevada, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 391 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (the "License"). Such License is as follows: Standard – Substitute PK-12. The License expires on October 3, 2026. (A true and correct copy of the License is attached as Exhibit A).

Petitioner hereby files this Petition and Recommendation in her official capacity as Superintendent of Public Instruction, Department of Education, State of Nevada. See NRS 391.322. The State Board of Education may revoke or suspend Respondent's license, if recommended by the

1 Superintendent of Public Instruction or the Board of Trustees of a School District, after notice and
2 opportunity for hearing, based upon the NRS 391.330 grounds for suspension and revocation. See also
3 NRS 391.320; NRS 391.322; NRS 391.330.

4 **II. Factual Allegations**

5 According to the Criminal Complaint filed in the Justice Court, North Las Vegas Township,
6 Clark County, Nevada, (a true and correct copy of which is attached as Exhibit B) on or about August
7 19, 2024, Respondent did commit the crime of Possession of Dangerous Weapon on School Property
8 (Gross Misdemeanor – NRS 202.265 – NOC 51432). This crime was committed by Respondent as she
9 did willfully and unlawfully carry or possess, while on the school property of LEGACY HIGH
10 SCHOOL, at 150 West Deer Springs Road, Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, a Glock firearm, bearing
11 Serial No. BMGB714.
12

13 On or about October 31, 2024, the Justice Court, North Las Vegas Township, Clark County,
14 Nevada, acknowledge Respondent's guilty plea and adjudged Respondent guilty of Concealed
15 Weapons Prohibited Without Permit (Misdemeanor – NOC 57945). (A true and correct copy of the
16 Court Docket is attached hereto as Exhibit C).
17

18 According to the Court Docket, the Court sentenced Respondent to the Clark County Detention
19 Center for thirty (30) days for the crime of Concealed Weapons Prohibited Without Permit
20 (Misdemeanor – NOC 57945).
21

22 In addition, according to the Court Docket, the Court suspended the prison sentence and
23 admitted Respondent to probation for a period and included the following special conditions:

- 24 1. Respondent must stay out of trouble.
- 25 2. Respondent must pay a \$400 fine or complete 33 hours of community service
- 26 3. If Respondent completes requirements, the case will be dismissed.
- 27

1 **III. Legal Allegations**

2 NRS 391.330(1), states as follows in pertinent part:

3 (a) Unprofessional conduct.

4 By committing the acts that constituted the crime of Concealed Weapons Prohibited Without
5 Permit (Misdemeanor – NOC 57945) and being convicted of said offense, Respondent has subjected
6 Respondent's license to revocation or suspension by violation of the following:

7 (a) NRS 391.330(l)(a) Unprofessional conduct.

8 **IV. Notice of Right to Hearing**

9 Respondent is hereby given notice of the recommendation by the Superintendent of Public
10 Instruction for the revocation of Respondent's license. The protocol and procedure for the suspension or
11 revocation of a license are set forth in NRS 391.320 to 391.361, inclusive. Respondent has the right to a
12 hearing on this Petition and Recommendation before a hearing officer, who will be selected pursuant to
13 NRS 391.322, to answer the allegations of the Petition and Recommendation and to present evidence
14 and argument on all issues involved, either personally or through an attorney.

15 If Respondent desires a hearing before a hearing officer, Respondent must file a written request
16 within **fifteen (15) days** from the receipt of this Petition and Recommendation as provided in NRS
17 391.322. Respondent's request should be addressed to the Superintendent of Public Instruction, Nevada
18 Department of Education, 700 East 5th Street, Carson City, Nevada, 89701-5096 or via email at
19 marakawa@doe.nv.gov. If Respondent requests a hearing, a hearing officer will be selected pursuant to
20 NRS 391.322, and that hearing officer will notify Respondent, in writing, of the time and location of the
21 hearing not less than ten (10) days before the hearing. If Respondent requests a hearing and a hearing
22 officer is selected, the procedures for the suspension or revocation of licenses found in NAC 391.500 to
23 391.555, inclusive, will be followed as appropriate. Pursuant to NAC 391.507, "[n]ot later than ten (10)
24 days after a hearing officer is selected pursuant to NRS 391.322, the holder of the license shall submit

1 to the hearing officer an answer to the allegations set forth" in this Petition and Recommendation. If no
2 request for a hearing is filed within the time specified, the State Board of Education may suspend or
3 revoke Respondent's license or take no action on the recommendation.

4 WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that the State Board of Education issue its decision to revoke
5 Respondent's license.

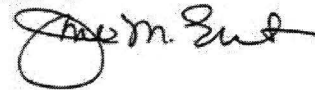

Red). Salters advised that she observed the firearm lying next to her front driver side tire and reported it to Bandiera who was carpooling with her. Bandiera advised her to not touch it and contacted CCSDPD.

The location was photographed and then the firearm was rendered safe. The firearm is a Glock 43X 9x19 (9mm) (Serial #BMGB714). The Glock had 10 total rounds in the magazine with 1 loaded in the chamber. The Glock was secured at that time. The Glock firearm will be processed, secured, and booked into CCSDPD evidence accordingly.

The red SUV was identified as a Red 2022 Nissan Pathfinder bearing NV license plate (952ZNJ) (VIN#5N1DR3BB2NC239512). The vehicle registered owner was identified as McClellan.

Dispatch was requested to perform a record check of the firearm (GLOCK), Pathfinder and McClellan to include a Triple III due to the weapon. McClellan returned as having no wants or holds. McClellan does have an active Concealed Carry Weapons Permit (CCW). The vehicle returned as having no wants or holds. The firearm returned as having no record.

McClellan is assigned to room #717 and I initially attempted to make contact with her in the room and was unsuccessful. McClellan was called over the PA system and I saw her walking in the hallway shortly afterward. Contact was made with McClellan in the hallway. McClellan was advised that she was requested by us and that we needed to talk to her in regards to an incident. McClellan is on crutches and was asked if she wanted to come to the police office or any conference room to talk and she advised the police office. Once inside the police office, McClellan was advised of her Miranda Rights which she initially advised didn't need, but was advised of regardless. McClellan advised that she understood and waived her rights. McClellan was advised that a firearm was found next to her vehicle and was asked if it belonged to her. McClellan did not initially answer and was advised that it was reported that she owns a firearm and that this firearm may belong to her. McClellan advised that she has a Glock 43. McClellan then advised that she may have dropped the firearm this morning out of her lockbox when she was unloading her vehicle due to being on crutches. McClellan advised that she doesn't know if she had her firearm in her purse or in the lockbox though. McClellan later advised that she drives Uber and keeps her firearm in a holster in her purse and forgot to remove it this morning. McClellan claimed ownership of the firearm at that time. McClellan asked what would happen next and was advised that she would be arrested and transported to Clark County Detention Center (CCDC). McClellan was cooperative throughout the investigation and continued to ask questions in regards to charges and her employment status.

Principal Belinda Marentic was updated on the incident. Marentic was provided the school keys and Emergency Card given to McClellan via CCSD. Marentic updated EMR on the incident and it was

determined that McClellan would be terminated on the spot. Marentic advised McClellan per NRS 207.200 that if she returned to Legacy HS she would be considered trespassing and subject to arrest. McClellan provided Marentic her purse, bag, and keys to the vehicle and advised that a friend would be by to pick up the items. McClellan was advised that CCSDPD would not be responsible or be present for that exchange. Officer Larsen brought a wheelchair to the police office to transport McClellan to the Patrol unit due to her claiming she was unable to walk and needed crutches. Once McClellan saw the wheel chair she advised that she does not need that and would not get into the chair, but wished to walk. Officer Larsen positioned his patrol unit near the 800 hallway to make it the shortest and most private walk possible. Officer Larsen placed McClellan into 2 handcuffs due to her claim of injury and for comfort purposes. Prior to exiting the building she was searched incident to arrest and nothing of note was discovered on her pursue. Officer Larsen placed her McClellan in the vehicle and secured her with the seatbelt without incident. Jynnell McClellan was transported to Clark County Detention Center and booked in on the below listed charges; • Possession of Dangerous Weapon on School Grounds (Gross Misdemeanor) in violation of NRS 202.265.1F due to the fact that Jynnell McClellan did willfully and unlawfully bring a Glock 43X firearm onto Legacy High School property and dropped it in the parking lot next to her vehicle. • Possession of Dangerous Weapon on School Grounds (Gross Misdemeanor) in violation of NRS 202.265.1G due to the fact that Jynnell McClellan did willfully and unlawfully bring an Asp Metro Defender Keychain Pepper Spray Baton onto Legacy High School property into her assigned classroom and had it in her purse throughout the school day. In addition to the above written report the following occurred. CCSDPD Dispatch was provided a copy of the firearm property sheet via email. Based on the location of the recovered firearm, the version of events described by McClellan does not appear to be accurate. McClellan vehicle was reversed parked into the parking stall with the firearm being discovered next to the driver side rear passenger side of the vehicle. McClellan claimed that the firearm fell out of either her purse or the lock box on the passenger side of the vehicle while obtaining all of her school supplies which would be the opposite side of the vehicle. It is to be notated that the firearm was left out side in the open for the entirety of the school day with her contracted start time being 0646 hrs and the firearm being discovered at 1353 hrs. were present and walked by the loaded firearm for extended periods of time. The school security footage was reviewed utilizing Camera #8 0630 to 0720 hrs on 8-19-2024. CCSD Security services was contacted via email and the security footage was requested for evidence. On 8-21-2024 Security Services Provided the link to the requested video. The video footage was transferred to a DVD+R and secured as evidence. The evidence was booked into CCSDPD evidence accordingly. Camera Review: At 0659 hrs McClellan Pathfinder was observed parking in the parking stall. At 0700 hrs McClellan is observed exiting the vehicle and walking toward the school building. McClellan is not observed going to the passenger side of the vehicle. McClellan is not observed dropping her items as she previously claimed. McClellan is observed walking into the school holding the crutches in 1 hand. 12 Jhone Ebert, Superintendent of Public Instruction, Department of Education, State of Nevada
13 ("Petitioner"), hereby petitions the State Board of Education for the revocation of the teacher license
14 held by JYNNELL MCCLELLAN ("Respondent"), issued by the Nevada Department of Education.
15 This Petition and Recommendation for Revocation of License and Notice of Right to Hearing ("Petition
16 and Recommendation") is supported by NRS 391.320, NRS 391.330, and the following allegations:

18 **I. Jurisdiction**

19 Respondent was, at the relevant times mentioned in this Petition and Recommendation, the
20 holder of License No. 106542 issued by the Superintendent of Public Instruction, Department of
21 Education, State of Nevada, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 391 of the Nevada Revised Statutes
22 (the "License"). Such License is as follows: Standard – Substitute PK-12. The License expires on
23 October 3, 2026. (A true and correct copy of the License is attached as Exhibit A).

24
25 Petitioner hereby files this Petition and Recommendation in her official capacity as
26 Superintendent of Public Instruction, Department of Education, State of Nevada. See NRS 391.322.
27 The State Board of Education may revoke or suspend Respondent's license, if recommended by the
28

1 Superintendent of Public Instruction or the Board of Trustees of a School District, after notice and
2 opportunity for hearing, based upon the NRS 391.330 grounds for suspension and revocation. See also
3 NRS 391.320; NRS 391.322; NRS 391.330.

4 **II. Factual Allegations**

5 According to the Criminal Complaint filed in the Justice Court, North Las Vegas Township,
6 Clark County, Nevada, (a true and correct copy of which is attached as Exhibit B) on or about August
7 19, 2024, Respondent did commit the crime of Possession of Dangerous Weapon on School Property
8 (Gross Misdemeanor – NRS 202.265 – NOC 51432). This crime was committed by Respondent as she
9 did willfully and unlawfully carry or possess, while on the school property of LEGACY HIGH
10 SCHOOL, at 150 West Deer Springs Road, Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada, a Glock firearm, bearing
11 Serial No. BMGB714.
12

13 On or about October 31, 2024, the Justice Court, North Las Vegas Township, Clark County,
14 Nevada, acknowledge Respondent's guilty plea and adjudged Respondent guilty of Concealed
15 Weapons Prohibited Without Permit (Misdemeanor – NOC 57945). (A true and correct copy of the
16 Court Docket is attached hereto as Exhibit C).
17

18 According to the Court Docket, the Court sentenced Respondent to the Clark County Detention
19 Center for thirty (30) days for the crime of Concealed Weapons Prohibited Without Permit
20 (Misdemeanor – NOC 57945).
21

22 In addition, according to the Court Docket, the Court suspended the prison sentence and
23 admitted Respondent to probation for a period and included the following special conditions:

- 24 1. Respondent must stay out of trouble.
- 25 2. Respondent must pay a \$400 fine or complete 33 hours of community service
- 26 3. If Respondent completes requirements, the case will be dismissed.
- 27

1 **III. Legal Allegations**

2 NRS 391.330(1), states as follows in pertinent part:

3 (a) Unprofessional conduct.

4 By committing the acts that constituted the crime of Concealed Weapons Prohibited Without
5 Permit (Misdemeanor – NOC 57945) and being convicted of said offense, Respondent has subjected
6 Respondent's license to revocation or suspension by violation of the following:

7 (a) NRS 391.330(l)(a) Unprofessional conduct.

8 **IV. Notice of Right to Hearing**

9 Respondent is hereby given notice of the recommendation by the Superintendent of Public
10 Instruction for the revocation of Respondent's license. The protocol and procedure for the suspension or
11 revocation of a license are set forth in NRS 391.320 to 391.361, inclusive. Respondent has the right to a
12 hearing on this Petition and Recommendation before a hearing officer, who will be selected pursuant to
13 NRS 391.322, to answer the allegations of the Petition and Recommendation and to present evidence
14 and argument on all issues involved, either personally or through an attorney.

15 If Respondent desires a hearing before a hearing officer, Respondent must file a written request
16 within **fifteen (15) days** from the receipt of this Petition and Recommendation as provided in NRS
17 391.322. Respondent's request should be addressed to the Superintendent of Public Instruction, Nevada
18 Department of Education, 700 East 5th Street, Carson City, Nevada, 89701-5096 or via email at
19 marakawa@doe.nv.gov. If Respondent requests a hearing, a hearing officer will be selected pursuant to
20 NRS 391.322, and that hearing officer will notify Respondent, in writing, of the time and location of the
21 hearing not less than ten (10) days before the hearing. If Respondent requests a hearing and a hearing
22 officer is selected, the procedures for the suspension or revocation of licenses found in NAC 391.500 to
23 391.555, inclusive, will be followed as appropriate. Pursuant to NAC 391.507, "[n]ot later than ten (10)
24 days after a hearing officer is selected pursuant to NRS 391.322, the holder of the license shall submit

1 to the hearing officer an answer to the allegations set forth" in this Petition and Recommendation. If no
2 request for a hearing is filed within the time specified, the State Board of Education may suspend or
3 revoke Respondent's license or take no action on the recommendation.

4 WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that the State Board of Education issue its decision to revoke
5 Respondent's license.

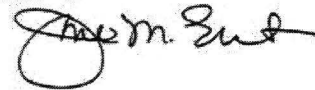

Red). Salters advised that she observed the firearm lying next to her front driver side tire and reported it to Bandiera who was carpooling with her. Bandiera advised her to not touch it and contacted CCSDPD.

The location was photographed and then the firearm was rendered safe. The firearm is a Glock 43X 9x19 (9mm) (Serial #BMGB714). The Glock had 10 total rounds in the magazine with 1 loaded in the chamber. The Glock was secured at that time. The Glock firearm will be processed, secured, and booked into CCSDPD evidence accordingly.

The red SUV was identified as a Red 2022 Nissan Pathfinder bearing NV license plate (952ZNJ) (VIN#5N1DR3BB2NC239512). The vehicle registered owner was identified as McClellan.

Dispatch was requested to perform a record check of the firearm (GLOCK), Pathfinder and McClellan to include a Triple III due to the weapon. McClellan returned as having no wants or holds. McClellan does have an active Concealed Carry Weapons Permit (CCW). The vehicle returned as having no wants or holds. The firearm returned as having no record.

McClellan is assigned to room #717 and I initially attempted to make contact with her in the room and was unsuccessful. McClellan was called over the PA system and I saw her walking in the hallway shortly afterward. Contact was made with McClellan in the hallway. McClellan was advised that she was requested by us and that we needed to talk to her in regards to an incident. McClellan is on crutches and was asked if she wanted to come to the police office or any conference room to talk and she advised the police office. Once inside the police office, McClellan was advised of her Miranda Rights which she initially advised didn't need, but was advised of regardless. McClellan advised that she understood and waived her rights. McClellan was advised that a firearm was found next to her vehicle and was asked if it belonged to her. McClellan did not initially answer and was advised that it was reported that she owns a firearm and that this firearm may belong to her. McClellan advised that she has a Glock 43. McClellan then advised that she may have dropped the firearm this morning out of her lockbox when she was unloading her vehicle due to being on crutches. McClellan advised that she doesn't know if she had her firearm in her purse or in the lockbox though. McClellan later advised that she drives Uber and keeps her firearm in a holster in her purse and forgot to remove it this morning. McClellan claimed ownership of the firearm at that time. McClellan asked what would happen next and was advised that she would be arrested and transported to Clark County Detention Center (CCDC). McClellan was cooperative throughout the investigation and continued to ask questions in regards to charges and her employment status.

Principal Belinda Marentic was updated on the incident. Marentic was provided the school keys and Emergency Card given to McClellan via CCSD. Marentic updated EMR on the incident and it was

determined that McClellan would be terminated on the spot. Marentic advised McClellan per NRS 207.200 that if she returned to Legacy HS she would be considered trespassing and subject to arrest. McClellan provided Marentic her purse, bag, and keys to the vehicle and advised that a friend would be by to pick up the items. McClellan was advised that CCSDPD would not be responsible or be present for that exchange. Officer Larsen brought a wheelchair to the police office to transport McClellan to the Patrol unit due to her claiming she was unable to walk and needed crutches. Once McClellan saw the wheel chair she advised that she does not need that and would not get into the chair, but wished to walk. Officer Larsen positioned his patrol unit near the 800 hallway to make it the shortest and most private walk possible. Officer Larsen placed McClellan into 2 handcuffs due to her claim of injury and for comfort purposes. In addition to the above written report the following occurred. CCSDPD Dispatch was provided a copy of the firearm property sheet via email. Based on the location of the recovered firearm, the version of events described by McClellan does not appear to be accurate. McClellan vehicle was reversed parked into the parking stall with the firearm being discovered next to the driver side rear passenger side of the vehicle. were present and walked by the loaded firearm for extended periods of time. The school security footage was reviewed utilizing Camera #8 0630 to 0720 hrs on 8-19-2024. CCSD Security services was contacted via email and the security footage was requested for evidence. On 8-21-2024 Security Services Provided the link to the requested video. The video footage was transferred to a DVD+R and secured as evidence. The evidence was booked into CCSDPD evidence accordingly. 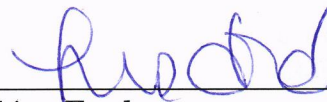
