- Bishop Manogue Catholic High School, Washoe County
- Noble Collegiate Academy, Clark County
- The Wharton School (Online), Clark County

BACKGROUND: Private education institutions are covered by Chapter 394 in both the Nevada Revised Statutes and the Nevada Administrative Code. The Private Schools Education Programs Professional verifies that the statutory and regulatory requirements are met. The Nevada State Board of Education approves the issuing of a private school license.

School Name: Primrose School of Las Vegas, Clark County

Background: This is the first license renewal for Primrose School of Las Vegas. Primrose is a pre-school with a single kindergarten classroom designated at each of its campuses. Primrose incorporates "playful exploration, teacher-guided inquiry and rich discussion" into its service delivery to introduce and reinforce new concepts and understanding. Although the focus is on developing math and literacy skills, the school also aims "to foster active minds, healthy bodies, and happy hearts." Currently, the Lone Mountain Campus is the only campus with kindergarten students, but the school hopes to enroll kindergarten students at its Silverado Campus in the coming school year.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve Primrose School of Las Vegas for a license for two years from March 31, 2025, through March 31, 2027. Primrose School of Las Vegas has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements.

School Name: Bishop Manogue Catholic High School, Washoe County

Background: Faith, Leadership, Knowledge, and Compassion are the pillars on which Bishop Manogue is based. The school offers a college preparatory curriculum and offers several Advanced Placement classes. It also offers a variety of electives including Sports Medicine, Leadership and Debate. The student: teacher ratio is 18:1 allowing each teacher to understand and meet the needs of each student. Juniors and seniors are offered internships opportunities so they can earn valuable on-site experience in a chosen career field.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve Bishop Manogue Catholic School for a license for four years from October 31, 2025, through October 31, 2029. Bishop Manogue Catholic School has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements.

Background: Noble Collegiate Academy has been in operation for 29 years. The school offers a "transformative learning experience" that ultimately "helps students become successful professionals and make an impact on the world." The school is bilingual and offers instruction in both English and Chinese. The small class sizes allow teachers to get to know each child, so they can individualize the learning experience. The curriculum is accelerated in each core subject. The school also offers classes in logic, coding, research skills, music and the arts, and offers opportunities for international field trips.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the State Board approve Noble Collegiate Academy for a license for four years from March 31, 2025, through March 31, 2029. Noble Collegiate Academy has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements.

SUBJECT: Private School Agent Permit

The applicant has also indicated whether they have a child support obligation and if so, whether it is current or in arrears. The Agent Permit will be valid from March 12, 2025 - January 1, 2026.
