#### **High School Start Time Survey**

In early 2024, the Nevada Department of Education was tasked with creating a survey to gather input on a potential change in high school start times. To assist in this effort, the Department partnered with Thought Exchange, a company specializing in dynamic survey platforms, to develop and launch a survey to gather and measure stakeholder input. The State Board of Education is committed to enhancing student performance across the state, but it faces significant challenges, such as chronic absenteeism, behavioral issues, and low academic achievement.
