BLASST is a package of evidence-based behavioral, social, and educational approaches offered to CCSD students in grades K-2 with significant behavioral challenges who spend the majority of their time in the general education setting. The service is consistent with the integrated MTSS framework and serves students who have failed to make progress via traditional Tier 3 approaches to behavior change within school settings.
