

Regulation Topic/Title R082-25 Frameworks for a Model Plan to Respond to Crisis, Suicide, or Emergency

<i>Summary</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This regulation requires that when developing, reviewing, or updating a model plan for the management of a crisis, emergency, or suicide, the Department must identify nationally recognized best practices, models, or frameworks. If the Department is unable to identify nationally recognized frameworks, the Department is required to develop their own. Once such a framework has been identified or developed, it must be presented to the State Board and posted online.
<i>Background</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Department has identified the Readiness and Emergency Management for Schools (REMS) Guide for Developing High-Quality School Emergency Operations Plans as the nationally recognized best practice/model/framework. However, please note that federal funding for REMS has recently been cut and technical assistance, along with their website and resources, is no longer available.
<i>Problem of Practice Development</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This regulation recognizes a routine practice to ensure high quality emergency operations plans. The Department developed this regulation internally and did not engage with districts in its development. However, the adoption of the REMS Guide has been in place for several years and is acknowledged by the field as the national guideline.

<i>Inflection Points</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> N/A
<i>History</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> This regulation was originally R132-20 and was initiated following the 2019 Legislative Session. However, this regulation “fell through the cracks” and is now being recirculated for finalization. However, the actual practice (i.e., promulgating national best practices) has been in place since that time.
