1. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Meeting called to order at 3:01 p.m. by Anderson. Quorum established.

2. PUBLIC COMMENT #1

3. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

Meeting minutes from February meeting was motioned for approval by Member Grennan to be accepted as they stand. Seconded by Member Tims. No further discussion and passed unanimously.

No further discussion, passed unanimously.
