Teacher Academy College Pathway Program provides reimbursement for tuition, registration, and other fees for college courses in the program.

Nevada's Teacher Academy College Pathway Program (TACPP) provides a direct path with lots of support to become a teacher, starting in high school.

HERE'S HOW:

-  **Multi-level entry points:** Accessible for students enrolled in grades 9-12. You can start as a freshman, or access later in high school - even as a senior.
-  **Seamless Transition to College:** Secure guaranteed admission to an NSHE institution and eligible employment opportunities during your college years.
-  **Tuition-Free Learning:** Earn free college units while in high school and receive reimbursement for all college tuition and fees after teaching three years in Nevada public schools.
-  **Lifetime Opportunities:** Participate in professional development, mentor future cohorts, and grow in a supportive educational community.
